ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

Through our charitable investments, Education First FCU helps enrich the lives of our members and the communities we serve with our Blue Jean Fund. Three (3) non-profit organizations will each receive a \$4,500 grant. Our general policy is against funding positions, salaries or other continuing operational expenses that would cause the organization to become dependent upon continued support.



GUIDELINES:

- Funds must be used within 12 months of receiving grant.
- Organizations must be non-discriminatory for any reason.
- Grants will address the following areas of civic and social concerns: arts and culture, preservation, education, health, social services, youth and elderly social services, and economic development.
- EFFCU employee committee will determine grant winners by a point system.

ELIGIBLE NON-PROFIT QUALIFICATIONS:

- Applicants must have received a tax exemption as a 501(c)(3) organization before applying and must attach a copy of the IRS exemption letter to the grant application.
- Organizations requesting support from the Blue Jean Fund must serve a community within Education First's field of membership, including Hardin, Jasper, Jefferson, Newton, Orange, and Tyler counties as well as East Chambers ISD and High Island ISD.
